1. Call to Order-Roll Call

- Tom is moving into programming full-time and will help out at the desk as needed. He took over the FOL Forums program from Bob Mueller. Bob will handle the Film group.
- Tom will also be working in the History room and on the project since Stacey is away on medical leave.
- Chad and Julie met with Ed Lijewski Jr. to get pricing on the construction of the history room project. We hope to have the total cost soon, and that would include cabinetry and furniture.
